



# DAVID CROCKETT BIRTHPLACE STATE PARK

### PARK DESCRIPTION

David Crockett was a pioneer, soldier, and politician. He was born near the town of Limestone, Tenn. in 1786. David Crockett Birthplace State Park commemorates the birthplace of this famous Tennessean. In 1817, he moved to Lawrence County. While serving in Congress, he fought for his people's right to keep land they had settled on in the new frontier of West Tennessee. Crockett died at the Alamo Mission in March of 1836 while aiding the Texans in their fight for independence from Mexico. David Crockett Birthplace State Park became a state park in 1973.

#### Campground Description

*2 Camping Areas: A & B*

*The campground is located at the entrance of the park near the beautiful Nolichucky River and just past the main entrance sign. A swimming pool and a playground are located adjacent to the camping area. A large picnic pavilion is located in the campground and is used exclusively by registered campers.*

#### Host Site Description

*Schedule: March - October*

There are 4 host positions at David Crockett Birthplace. All host sites are located in the A section and in the middle rows. Each is a pull-through site that includes water, sewer, and electric up to 50 amp.
