



# HARRISON BAY STATE PARK

## CAMPGROUND HOST INFORMATION



### PARK DESCRIPTION

Harrison Bay State Park is a 1,200 acre park with approximately 40 miles of Chickamauga Lake shoreline, and was originally developed as a Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) recreation area in the 1930s. Its name is derived from a large bay at the main channel of the Tennessee River that covers the old town of Harrison, and the last Cherokee Campground. The parklands are historically significant because the Cherokee Campground consisted of three villages which were ruled by one of the last great Cherokee Chieftains. Harrison Bay became the first Tennessee State Park in 1937.

### HOSTING DESCRIPTION

#### Campground Description

*Campgrounds: A, B, C*

- Harrison Bay State Park campgrounds (A-C) are located along Chickamauga Lake and North of our Marina. All campgrounds can be found past our Camp Store on both the left and right side of the road. All sites offer water and 20, 30, 50 Amp electric, but no sewer hook-up.

**A** - Mostly open with some wooded areas. Has paved/level sites and a variety of pull through or back-in options. Some sites are longer and can accommodate larger RVs. Total of 47 sites

**B** - Mostly wooded with a variety of site sizes, slope and pull through or back-in options. Total of 48 sites

**C** - Wooded with a variety of site sizes, slope and pull through or back-in options. All sites are gravel with a few offering waterfront. Total of 40 sites

#### Host Site Description

*Schedule: Year-Round*

**A** - Host site is A29: Site is a large back-in, paved site with retaining wall built on the back side. It is an open site with a wooded area directly behind it that provides some shade. Located in middle of campground near the A bathhouse. Has sewer hook-up.

**B** - Host site is B48: A large pull through, paved site with some trees for shade. Located directly across the road from the Camp Store and is near B Bathhouse at the exit of campground. Has sewer hook-up.

**C** - Host site is C40: is a back-in graveled site with a wooded area surrounding it. It is located directly behind Bathhouse C and is near waterfront sites. NO sewer hook-up.

- Post hang tags when needed

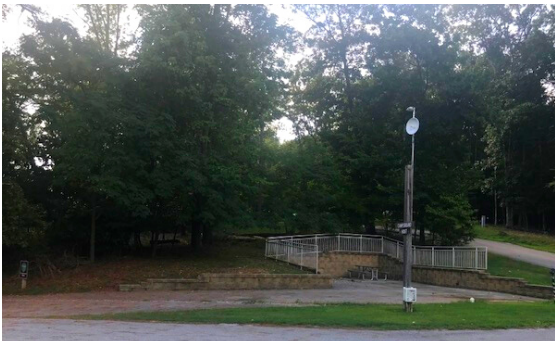
