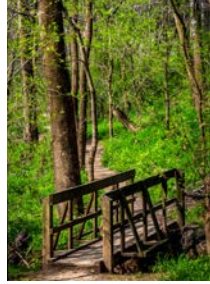
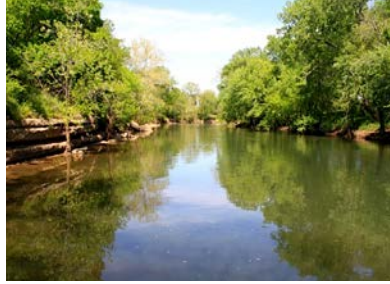




HENRY HORTON STATE PARK

PARK DESCRIPTION

Henry Horton State Park was constructed in the 1960s on the estate of Tennessee Governor Henry Hollis Horton. The park is located on the shores of the historic Duck River, one of the most bio-diverse ecosystems in the world. Remnants of a mill and bridge, operated by the Wilhoite family for over a century, can be viewed today on the Wilhoite Mill Trail.

Campground Description

RV Campground

This campground has 54 RV sites, 19 tent sites, 6 hammock sites and a group campsite all along a wooded loop and situated near the Duck River on the north-west side of the park. The campground also offers a newly renovated camp store for all your camping essentials.

Host Site Description

Schedule: Year-Round / March - November

Host Site 30 is next to the RV bathhouse on the back side of the RV camping loop. It has a sewage hookup with 20, 30, 50 amp electric and water. The site is shaded with plenty of trees.

Host Site 51 is near the entrance to the RV loop and next to the camp store. It has a sewage hookup with 20, 30, and 50 amp electric and water. The site is shaded with plenty of trees.

Responsibilities

- Check-in campers & customer service
- Assist campers with reserving and changing site reservations
- Assist in the camp store when needed
- Other responsibilities on an as needed basis:
- Blow and pick up around campsites as needed
- Clean fire rings as needed
- General clean up, etc. of the campground as needed
